Wrightsville Borough Municipal Authority has agreed to a \$2.50 increase per month for refuse service until the end of current contract. Current contract will end December 2018. Municipal Authority will no longer collect refuse at the end of the contract.

Councilman White seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.
