The Planning Meeting of the Borough of Wrightsville governing body convened at 6:30PM on Monday, April 17, 2017. President Bolton called the meeting to order and led the salute to the American Flag.

Ed Sipes:

Mr. Sipes inquired about complaint turned in concerning the sight distance at 9th and Locust streets. President Bolton said the matter will be looked at and action will be taken, if needed. Councilman Gromling indicated that a traffic study may need to be completed according to PennDOT publications.

Larry Kirkessner Jr.:

Mr. Kirkessner presented council members with a letter of interest to fill vacant council position for 1st ward.

ACTION ITEMS:

President Bolton accepted nominations for vacant council position. Councilman McDonald nominated Larry Kirkessner Jr. Councilman Gromling seconded the nomination. Councilman McDonald made a motion to appoint Larry Kirkessner Jr. to fill vacancy for council position. Vice-President White seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

BOROUGH COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Administration & Finance:

Councilman Gromling stated that all expenditures over \$200.00 should be approved by committee chairs until an ambulance contract is approved. President Bolton agreed based on not having knowledge of costs associated with providing ambulance services in the borough after May 31, 2017.

President Bolton indicated that any employee who wants to attend training seminars should be permitted to attend to enhance knowledge of work.

Public Works:

Heritage Day banner will be hung when equipment is available for use. Councilman Gromling indicated it should be done within 1-2 weeks or sooner.

Public Safety:

President Bolton indicated that both crossing guards are resigning effective the end of the 2016-2017 school year.

Solicitor Fields indicated that the Eastern York School Board would need to adopt a resolution to take full ownership of crossing guards and their employment.

Councilman Gromling and President Bolton indicated that ambulance discussions will continue to be on the agenda until an agreement is finalized.

Councilman Gromling indicated that he removed the Little Tykes play side from the park to prevent any hazardous accidents from occurring.
