

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 4

**AN ORDINANCE OF WRIGHTSVILLE BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 4 (BUILDINGS) OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, Borough Zoning Ordinance was adopted by the Borough of Wrightsville on September 19, 2013 by the Borough Council of the Wrightsville implementing a Zoning Ordinance for the Borough where one had not existed previously.

WHEREAS, as a result of the adoption of the Zoning Ordinance, portions of Chapter 4 (Buildings) of the Wrightsville Borough Code either conflict with the newly adopted Zoning Ordinance or are redundant.

WHEREAS, those portions of Chapter 4 (Buildings) of the Wrightsville Borough Code that conflict with the newly adopted Zoning Ordinance or are redundant need to be repealed in order to eliminate the conflict between with the Zoning Ordinance or in order to remove the redundancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by Borough Council of Wrightsville as follows:


Section 1: Chapter 4, Part 3 (Building Lines) of the Wrightsville Borough Code is hereby rescinded and repealed in its entirety, and from the effective date of this Ordinance, each and every provision of Chapter 4, Part 3 (Building Lines) is declared to be null and void and of no force or effect.

Section 2: Chapter 4, Part 4 (Fences) of the Wrightsville Borough Code is hereby rescinded and repealed in its entirety, and from the effective date of this Ordinance, each and every provision of Chapter 4, Part 4 (Fences) is declared to be null and void and of no force or effect.


This Ordinance shall be effective as of the date of adoption.
