ORDINANCE 2016 -2

**AN ORDINANCE OF WRIGHTSVILLE BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 8 (FLOODPLAINS), PART 4
“IDENTIFICATION OF FLOODPLAIN AREAS”, SECTION 401 “IDENTIFICATION”
OF THE WRIGHTSVILLE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, in order for the Wrightsville Borough Floodplains Ordinance to be fully compliant with the National Flood Insurance Program, FEMA is requiring that the effective date of the Flood Insurance Rate Maps be changed from December 15, 2015 to December 16, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Wrightsville, York County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 8 (Floodplains), Part 4 “Identification of Floodplain Areas”, Section 401 of the Wrightsville Borough Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

§401. IDENTIFICATION.

The identified floodplain area shall be:

1. Any areas of Borough of Wrightsville, classified as Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHAs) in the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and the accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) dated December 16, 2015 and issued by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), or the most recent revision thereof, including all digital data developed as part of the Flood Insurance Study and;
2. Any Community Identified Flood Hazard Areas

The above referenced FIS and FIRMs, and any subsequent revisions and amendments are hereby adopted by Borough of Wrightsville and declared to be a part of this Chapter.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately after adoption.




