The Planning Meeting of the Borough of Wrightsville governing body convened at 6:32PM on Monday, September 21, 2020. Council President White called the meeting to order and led the salute to the American Flag.

ACTION ITEMS:

Councilman Bair made a motion to approve special handicap parking application for 530 S. Front Street. Councilman Kirkessner seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Vice President Smith made a motion to approve entertainment permit for the fire department chicken barbecue fundraiser on Sunday, October 4, 2020 from 7am-3pm. Councilman Bair seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Bair made a motion to approve closing 2nd Street at 100 block of Garden Avenue to Chestnut Street on Sunday, October 4, 2020 from 7am-3pm for fire department fund raiser. Councilman Gromling seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Engineer Klinedinst relayed to members of council that he completed a survey from York County Planning Commission that was sent on behalf of the Susquehanna Riverlands Conservation Landscape partnership. The main initiative of the survey is to develop an Integrated Land Management Plan (ILMP) to improve coordinated stewardship, connectivity, ecosystem health, and public access in the Susquehanna Riverlands Conservation Landscape region.

Council members reviewed proposal documents provided from Commonwealth Code to provide zoning, property code enforcement and Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code enforcement services to Wrightsville Borough.

Vice President Smith made a motion to notify Code Administrators to terminate our full service agreement with Code Administrators, Inc. and begin a full service agreement with Commonwealth Code Inspection Service, Inc. effective October 1, 2020 pending an agreement can be made to eliminate charges being assessed to applicant for phone calls made to Commonwealth Code for inquiries or questions about permit process. Councilman Kirkessner seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.
