### YARD WASTE PICK-UP

Yard waste pick-up will begin on Monday, March 6, 2023. Yard waste must be placed into brown biodegradable bags or trash cans filled with ONLY yard waste. Any yard waste that cannot be put into bags/cans may be bundled in no more than 4' length bundles and placed by the curb.

Yard waste placed into plastic bags will NOT be picked up.

### STREET SWEEPING IS AROUND THE CORNER!

Keep an eye out for **NO PARKING** signs on your street on the days of street sweeping. Residents are respectfully asked to refrain from sweeping gravel/stones into piles as it makes it more difficult to be picked up by the street sweeper.

### TREES, GRASS AND WEEDS

WB-IPMC – Chapter 3, Section 302.4 All premises and exterior property shall be maintained free from excessive weed or plant growth. Weeds are defined as all grasses, annual plants and vegetation, other than trees or shrubs provided; however, this term shall not include cultivated flowers and gardens





#### SOLID WASTE

Refuse containers are to be placed at the curb no earlier than the day before collection and must be removed by the end of the day of collection. Refuse containers must be leak-proof, insect/rodent-proof and equipped with tight-fitting lids.

In accordance with Chapter 6, Part 3, §307 of the Code of Ordinances, remember to always clean up after your dog to avoid creating an animal nuisance. Additionally, Chapter 2, Part 1, §102 states that allowing your cats/dogs to run at large within the Borough is prohibited.

### WITH SPRING & SUMMER AROUND THE CORNER, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT IT IS A VIOLATION OF BOROUGH ORDINANCES TO:

- Have grass growing over 6" inches or an accumulation of weeds
- Conduct open burning
- Have an accumulation of bulky rubbish on any property, such as excess trash, discarded furniture, large household appliances such as refrigerators, washing machines, bathtubs, sinks, toilets, etc.

### SAFETY REMINDERS

- Fill the tanks of lawn mowers, motorbikes and power saws only when the motor is cool and not when in an enclosed area
- Store gasoline in an approved safety can and in a cool area away from the house in a detached garage or shed
- Dispose of old cans of paint, paint thinners, and accumulated newspapers in the proper manner
- Change the batteries in all detectors (smoke & carbon monoxide) every year. The actual detector (smoke & carbon monoxide) should be replaced every 10 years
- Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors to ensure they are working properly
- Conduct a family fire drill. Review and practice your family escape plan
- Barbeque gas grills (including gas hoses) and propane tanks should be inspected before use
- Fire is NOT the way to get rid of yard waste. The burning of leaves and any general yard waste is not permitted within the Borough of Wrightsville.



## HISTORIC WRIGHTSVILLE INC.

As temperatures warm up, so do the HWI activities. We invite everyone to join us for our very popular annual **Olde Town Night** gathering. On Friday, **March 17**th, at 6:30pm, please join us in the sanctuary of Wrightsville Hope United Methodist Church to hear award-winning historian, **Scott Mingus**, present "Flames Beyond Gettysburg." This is a retelling of the Confederate march from Chambersburg to Wrightsville in 1863. Mr. Mingus was invited to share his knowledge with us as the year 2023 is the 160th anniversary of the burning of the Columbia-Wrightsville Bridge in response to the advancing Confederate troops. This is a free event, but we ask that reserve your place by calling 717-252-1169. Leave the name and number in your party in your message. Please note that will be **no** social time prior to this gathering.

The Burning Bridge Diorama re-opens on **April 2nd** from its winter hiatus (it is unheated). Stop by on any Sunday from 1pm-4pm. Learn about Wrightsville's involvement in the Civil War.

A second "Remembering Wrightsville Businesses" meeting will be held at 6:30pm at the Methodist Church on ????, April ???. The speaker will be historian Stephen H, Smith, and his focus will be to "Examine Five Wrightsville Area Businesses from the Early 1900's." Those businesses will be Bailey's Garage, Susquehanna Steam Sawmills, Wrightsville Lime Company, Wrightsville Hardware Company, and Round Top Resort. This is also a free event, but we ask that you reserve your place by calling 717-252-1169.

More Wrightsville history, specifically the Confederate invasion and subsequent burning of the Columbia-Wrightsville bridge, will be presented during Riverfest Weekend, June 23, 24 & 25. The Museum will have the big reveal of a new display featuring the facts-of-life in Wrightsville during 1863 on Saturday. A request has been made by the Co-Historians for possible artifact loans from that time period. To lend or donate period artifacts, please contact the Museum at 717-252-1169, ask for Lisa or leave a message. On Saturday and Sunday, you will be able to view a live re-enactment of the life of Civil War soldiers at the Riverside Park on S. Front Street. On Sunday, HWI will host for the first time, multiple town wide bus tours that will explain the actual Invasion of Wrightsville. These tours are ticketed and by reservation only. ## EFFECTIVE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

### **ADOPT-A-STORM DRAIN**

It is very important that we work together to keep our storm drains working at 100% capacity at all times. Leaves, grass clippings, trash, branches, etc. can cause blockage which may result in dangerous street flooding if a storm hits

Please report any damaged or blocked storm drain inlets right away by calling the Water Department at 717-252-3711

If you decide to embark upon a do-it-yourself project rather than hire a contractor, take the time to educate yourself on the type of permit(s) that may be required. Residents and business owners should use Best Management Practices (BMP'S) to prevent or treat the water that flows from your property and into the Borough storm drains.



#### TIPS TO HELP KEEP OUR WATERWAYS CLEAN AND HEALTHY:

- Do not dump anything down storm sewers!
- Do not hose down yard debris. Sweep it up and throw it into a trash receptacle instead.
- Pick up pet waste immediately and dispose of it properly.
- Consider using permeable paving such as gravel and interlocking pavers.

### What is Stormwater Runoff?

Stormwater runoff is the mixture of rain water and pollution that is picked up as the rain water runs off of impervious surfaces such as buildings, parking lots, driveways and roads. This polluted rain water then drains into storm sewers which lead to major waterways such as rivers, lakes, seas and oceans. This pollution can be hazardous to plants, animals, fish and people.



### ZONING AND BUILDING PERMITS

All Zoning and Building permit paperwork is processed at the Borough office. Payment for both will also be collected at the Borough. If your project requires both a Zoning and Building Permit you will need to pay for each permit separately. Permit fees do not need to be paid until permit is approved and picked up.

### **DO I NEED A PERMIT?**

It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to erect, construct, enlarge, alter, move, improve, remove, convert or demolish any building/structure without a permit.

NO WORK CAN BE STARTED UNLESS PERMIT IS ISSUED FROM BOROUGH OFFICE!!

#### PROOF OF INSURANCE

Proof of Insurance is required on all projects in the form of a **Certificate of Liability** listing **Wrightsville Borough** as the **certificate holder**. If a contractor is doing the work, their liability insurance information is required. If a contractor is not employed, the homeowner must provide a copy of their homeowners insurance in the form of a certificate of liability. This is typically called an ACORD file.

### **TRASH RATE INCREASE FOR 2023**

Dear Wrightsville Municipal Authority Customers,



We regret to inform you that the trash billing rates will be increased as of January 2023 from \$25.50 to \$27.50 per month. This is due to the increase in tipping fees as well as the cost of fuel. The last time the trash rate was increased was July 2016.

We will continue to provide twice weekly trash pick-up, weekly recycling, leaf pickup in the fall and yard waste in the spring.


